

	<p><u>First Commandment and meaning</u> You shall have no other gods. <i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.</p>
	<p><u>Second Commandment and meaning</u> You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God. <i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.</p>
	<p><u>Third Commandment and meaning</u> Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. <i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred, and gladly hear and learn it.</p>
	<p><u>Fourth Commandment and meaning</u> Honor your father and your mother. <i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.</p>

	<p><u>Fifth Commandment and meaning</u> You shall not murder. <i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.</p>
	<p><u>Apostle's Creed</u> I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; He descended into Hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into Heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.</p>
